COMPETITION RULES

- Musicians through senior year of high school are eligible to compete.
 - Competition is open to **the following instruments only** (flute, oboe, clarinet, bassoon, trumpet, horn, trombone, tuba, piano, violin, viola, cello, string bass, and harp).
 - Musicians must perform **one movement (only)** of a standard concerto, which must be selected **from the list available on the LV Philharmonic website, or otherwise pre-approved by the Las Vegas Philharmonic.**
 - **Musicians must provide their own piano accompanist.** If a musician cannot provide their own accompanist, please contact the Las Vegas Philharmonic office to make arrangements for an accompanist.
 - Musicians must send a letter of recommendation from a teacher or other educational reference along with the completed application form to the **Las Vegas Philharmonic, 1412 S. Jones Blvd, LV 89146, or fax it to 893-7757.**
 - **Deadline for receiving the application is Nov. 1, 2010 at 5:00pm.**
 - Individual competition times will be announced after registration is closed.
 - Winners will be announced on the Las Vegas Philharmonic website, www.lvphil.com, the week following the competition and a letter will be mailed to all contestants with the results of the competition.
 - Winners will be selected from those who compete. Each winner may be invited to perform a portion of their concerto movement during the Las Vegas Philharmonic's Youth Concert Series in Artemus Ham Hall at UNLV, January 11th, 12th or 13th, 2011. A prize of \$1,000 will be awarded to each of the four winners. Winners must complete a W9 form and waiver.
